

RAINY LAKE VISITOR CENTER

Grand Tour - Boat Tour: This tour is a combination of the Discovery and Gold Mine Tour.

Discovery Cruise - Boat Tour: Discover the wonders and beauty of Voyageurs National Park. The captain will navigate Rainy Lake in search of abundant wildlife, eagles, and a historic commercial fish camp.

Gold Mine Tour - Boat Tour: This tour takes you to Little American Island where you may depart from the tour boat with a ranger for a 1/4 mile accessible walk through the remains of mining activities.

Starwatch Cruise - Boat Tour: Join a ranger for an adventure aboard The Voyageur to learn about the dark skies over Voyageurs. The boat will cruise to a quiet spot on Rainy Lake where the engines are cut so night sounds and dark skies can be optimized. A ranger will assist visitors to identify objects with the naked eye while learning about light pollution and what it means to be a Dark Sky Certified Park. There's always a chance the northern lights may dance for us. Bug spray, long-sleeved shirts, and pants recommended.

Kettle Falls Cruise - Boat Tour: Voyage to the Historic Kettle Falls Hotel area. This tour takes you back in time before the park was established by visiting places very few people traveled years ago. Spend 2.5-hours aboard The Voyageur on your way to Kettle Falls. Upon arrival, spend 2-hours on land touring the area and having lunch. Finally, enjoy a 2-hour cruise on your return trip. Visitors on this trip may bring their own lunch or are limited to select box lunches at Kettle Falls Hotel due to time constraints. Lunch not included in the tour price.

North Canoe Voyage: Paddle back in history aboard a 26-foot replica North Canoe. Learn the voyageur paddle salute, sing songs, and explore the life of a voyageur. Minimum age is 5, paddling required. We recommend participants know how to swim. Weather dependent. Reservations required. No loose items allowed on the trip.

Dark Skies over Voyageurs: If you want to truly experience a dark night sky, then plan on attending a staffled, land-based, sky viewing events throughout the summer. Observe the constellations, planets, and galaxies with telescope, and discover how to reduce light pollution.

KABETOGAMA LAKE VISITOR CENTER

Ellsworth Rock Gardens - Boat Tour: Board the Ne-zhodain and cruise a short distance to the Ellsworth Rock Gardens. Join a ranger for a 1/4 mile partially accessible tour by viewing unique rock sculptures, building remnants, and winding paths. Visitors will traverse a steep 60-foot incline and rocks are slippery when wet. Sturdy shoes, bug spray, and long-sleeved shirts are recommended.

ASH RIVER VISITOR CENTER

Kettle Falls Day Cruise - Boat Tour: Same description as above, just on the Ne-zho-dain and a stop at I.W. Stevens Island.

Kettle Falls Evening Cruise - Boat Tour: Same description as above, just in the afternoon/evening.

Ellsworth Rock Gardens - Boat Tour: Board the Ne-zhodain and cruise a short distance to the Ellsworth Rock Gardens. Join a ranger for a 1/4 mile partially accessible tour by viewing unique rock sculptures, building remnants, and winding paths. Visitors will traverse a steep 60-foot incline and rocks are slippery when wet. Sturdy shoes, bug spray, and long-sleeved shirts are recommended.

North Canoe Voyage: Same description as above.
